Puerto Rico's Historical Places

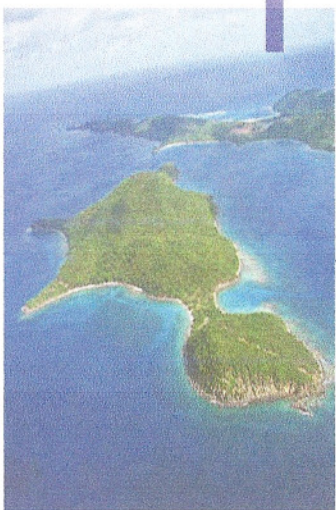

El Yunque is known as the Caribbean National Forest, 40 km southeast of San Juan. This is the only rainforest in the United States. It has over 240 species of trees and other plants. The Puerto Rican Parrot could be found in the rain forest, it is one of the 10 endangered birds in the world. El Yunque rains more than any of the National Forests with up to 240in per year. This rainforest is divided into four forest: Palma Sierra Forest, Palo Colorado Forest, En Las Nubes Forest, and the Tabonuco Forest.
