Want to see some action and experience culture at the same time? Head over to “Las Ventas” and experience true culture at a



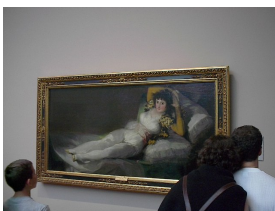
traditional Spanish bullfight. The best time to go is between May and June. They take place on Sunday nights at 7pm. This is one activity you cannot miss!

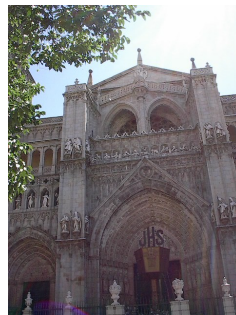
### TOLEDO
